The Council may inspect/visit the Institute any time it may deem fit to note progress/compliance.

The attention of the Management is drawn to the fact that the approval given now is only for the batch admitted during 1999-2000, at the end of which an Expert Committee shall visit to assess if the Norms and Standards as stipulated by AICTE are fulfilled, and only then will the continuation or otherwise shall be intimated.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress made by the above mentioned Institute for fulfillment of the Norms and Standards of the Council and keep the concerned Regional Office and AICTE, New Delhi informed.
